We are super excited for our field trip this Thursday and Friday! We almost ended up canceling due to conflicting weather reports, but it is on! The schedule has changed several times as we've tried to plan for different contingencies. This is the final schedule.

Kids and Cell Phones

We would like to remind all of our parents that students in school do not require the use of their personal phones. Any technologies our students require are provided for by the school. Students caught using personal devices without permission have them taken away by staff. These devices are then given back at the end of the day, along with all the others students who turned in their phones at the start of the day. For most students, this is enough of a warning so in the future they turn in their device when asked or they leave it at home.

If a student's personal device is removed by staff multiple times, the student will have their device confiscated until the end of the week. If a student who has already had their device confiscated for a whole week continues to use their device rather than focus on school, they may have the device confiscated for a full 30 days. Simply having a parent come and pick up the device does not change this rule. Frankly, in the past we have given parents back student devices before the time has expired and those same students are back in class on their devices a day or week later.

We understand why this may upset some parents. Da Vinci Tree Academy is one of the strictest schools in Arizona, and we like it this way. Phones in classrooms get in the way of the learning environment, amplify bullying, and facilitate drama and misunderstandings.

If letting your student use their cell phone during school is more important to you than the quality of your child's education, Mr. Roll, the Principal and Founder of Da Vinci Tree Academy, humbly suggests that we may not be the right school for you.

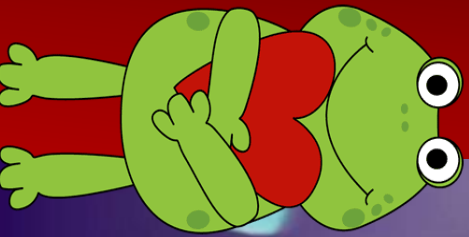

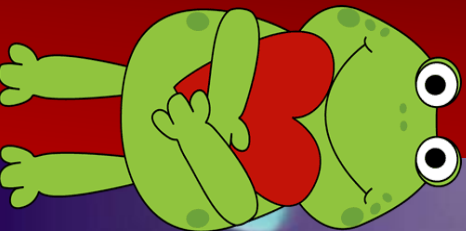
